



Floorworld Laminate Flooring Maintenance Guide

To ensure that you can clean and care for your new laminate floor from the day it was installed Floorworld has teamed up with leading Italian company Chimiver to produce a top quality Laminate Floor Cleaner that is suitable for all brands of laminate flooring that is available to purchase from Floorworld.

Laminate flooring is very versatile and hardwearing and when looked after correctly will last many years with minimal maintenance. However, laminate flooring does have limitations and should only be cleaned with a damp mop with all of the excess water expelled, wet mopping a laminate floor can cause serious damage and should be avoided at all costs, by following the guidelines below your laminate floor will provide many years of trouble free use.

Chimiver Laminate Floor Cleaner contains an anti-static emulsion which helps the absorption and the prevention of dust built up. Chimiver Laminate Floor Cleaner contains special nanoparticles which guarantee a deep and long lasting cleaning to the treated surface. Rinse free, it does not leave streaks assuring a fresh scent even in the presence of pets.

How to use:

- Pour 3 caps of product into 1L of clean warm water. For strong dirt, increase the concentration until 6 caps.
- Submerge the mop into the solution, ensure to thoroughly rinse the mop and expel all excess water before proceeding to clean the floor.
- Mop the floor using overlapping strokes to gain maximum cleaning
- Rinse the mop regularly in the solution.
- Allow the floor to dry completely before walking to avoid leaving footprints.

For a fast and prompt use, we suggest using the diluted solution in conjunction with a micro fibre spray mop and proceed to clean the floor, this will help reduce the chance of applying too much water and potentially damaging the floor.

Do's and Don'ts for laminate floor care

- Always fix self-adhesive felt pads to the base of all movable furniture, this will reduce the chance of scratching the floor.
- When moving heavy furniture always lift and do not drag, to avoid damaging the floor.
- It is strongly advised that entrance mats are used to remove from footwear sand, gravel, dirt and moisture, all of which can, over time cause damage to a laminate floor.
- Be sure to sweep the floor on a regular basis, whether you use vacuum attachments, a broom, or a dust mop, dirt works as an abrasive on laminate flooring and will reduce the shine. Be sure to get into the corners and get rid of dirt often.
- Try to maintain an ambient temperature of between 18-26 deg at all times, sudden fluctuations in temperature and humidity can cause problems and damage to laminate floors.
- Always deal with spills immediately, do not let liquids or water stand on the laminate floor long periods of time as this can cause damage to the floor.
- If Chimiver Laminate Floor cleaner is not available, then only a PH neutral floor cleaner can be used as a substitute, never use wax or polish on a laminate floor as this can make the floor slippery and become a safety hazard.
- Within offices and such like, use chairs and seats with soft casters that are suitable for laminate flooring or use a suitable desk floor mat to aid protection of the floor.
- Never use steam cleaners on a laminate floor, excess heat can cause damage to laminate flooring.
